

CODE OF CONDUCT

As we continue to develop Pax Dei with our players, we ask all community members to agree to the behavior expectations outlined below. This Code of Conduct is supplemental to the **Terms of Use**, which you must agree to before playing Pax Dei.

Community Values

As a company and as gamers, we wish our community to respect some basic but dear to our heart values.

- You shall be respectful of all community members,
- You shall not cheat,
- You shall protect yourself and others.

Behavior Expectations

To foster an environment in line with the values mentioned above, we expect every member of the community, including our employees and partners, to commit to the following behaviors:

RESPECT

All players should feel safe, welcome, and accepted in our community channels and in the game.

- Treat others as they wish to be treated. If you don't know, feel free to ask.
- Be aware of and respect individual differences and experiences. Pax Dei has a global community – we don't all speak the same language.
- Stop using a term if someone asks you not to use it—even if you don't think it's offensive.
- Stay calm. We all have times when emotions run high. If you need to, take a break and a deep breath, and pause the game.

- Don't use abusive language, slurs, or any form of hate speech.
- Don't make jokes about people. Behind every avatar, there is a real person.
- Do not bully, harass, or threaten others – being players or employees.
- Don't create characters or clans with offensive, illegal, or protected names.

CHEATING

Have fun and play fair. All players are created equal. Anything aimed at gaining an unfair advantage disrupts the balance of our game and is damaging to our community.

- Play fair and encourage others to do so.
- Call out cheating and help us foster fair play by reporting such situations.

- Don't cheat! Buying, making, distributing, or promoting cheats for our games ruins the experience for all, even you. (Cheats include exploits, automation software, emulators, bots, hacks, mods or any unauthorized third-party software designed to modify or interfere with the game.)
- Don't abuse exploits or glitches to gain an unfair advantage.

SELF-PROTECTION

Be responsible with your account, devices, personal information, and conduct.

- Use strong passwords and keep all your devices secure.
- Let us know as soon as possible if you think your account has been compromised.
- Log off when you get up from a computer, especially if it's not yours.
- Don't run third-party programs that interfere with gameplay. Anything that puts itself between you and our servers puts your account security at risk.
- Don't let friends play on your account. Accounts have a one-person limit.
- Don't Share personal information with strangers—yours or anyone else's.
- Don't impersonate anyone. That includes Mainframe employees, other players, and community figures.

Consequences

You are responsible for all actions and any comments you make in-game and on our channels. To protect our communities, employees, and partners, we may remove any content published by you that is in breach of this **Code of Conduct** or our **Terms of Use**.

In addition, we may restrict or remove your privileges or access to our game. This is to protect other players from further disruptions. While we might reconsider the sanction in case of appeal, this will not be to the detriment of the rest of our community.
